

Our back room 'Leading our Learning' is perfect for their transition from Reception! We love going in there on Friday afternoons!





Unfortunately, handwriting is at the top of the "endangered" human activities list, and it is likely to become extinct shortly!









However...beautiful handwriting is one of the most precious gifts that I can give to your child, as they can take it with them through their entire life!




