### Computing The Internet


· The children will be learning about the internet and how networks make connections.

# ...Home Learning..

In order for you to support your child with their learning, we have made our homework system as straight forward as possible

### Maths FIRST

Weekly homework will be set multiplication tables practice. Children are expected to spend 5 minutes x3 a week on TTRS which we are asking a parent to sign off on:

Where children are not completing homework, they will be invited to join our homework clubs that will run on Friday lunch time. Teachers will be there to support the children.

# ...Home Learning...

### Reading

All children, despite their age or ability, are encouraged to read at least 3 times per week. Once they have read, please make sure you complete their reading log, ticking for each read and signing it. Reading books will come home weekly. Your child's book swap day will be displayed at the top of their reading log for each half term.

Children will also receive comprehension bookmarks. Please also tick if you ask your child these questions while they are reading to you - they may earn an extra chance at a treat!

### LEVEL 1/5 Spelling

All children will be given a list of spellings on Friday, please support them by helping them to learn them; they will have a test the following Friday. Each week they will highlight the words that go correct on their homework sheets.





# ...Specific Assessment for your Year Group...

### What is the multiplication tables check?

It is an on-screen check consisting of 25 times table questions. Your child will be able to answer 3 practice questions before taking the actual check. They will then have 6 seconds to answer each question. On average, the check should take no longer than 5 minutes to complete.
