Our text:

This half term, we'll be learning about how to extend our sentences using 'and'. We will also begin to learn about the basic features of a diary entry.

Maths

In maths, we will be focusing on addition and subtraction. We will learn to add and subtract using resources, crossing out, and jumping forwards and backwards on a number line.
