

### Literacy

Our story this half term is Where the Forest Meets the Sea and Jungle Explorer.

The children will be creating a zoo information board for a rainforest exhibit. They will be focussing on conservation and choosing their own focus animal to write about.

### Maths

#### Fractions & Decimals

The children will be finishing their fractions unit, finding fractions of amounts before being introduced to tenths and hundredths as decimals..

#### Time

- The children will tell the time on an analogue clock to 5 minutes and to 1 minute. They will begin to read digital clocks in both 12 hour and 24 hour formats, noting the difference between am and pm.

### Geography

#### Waterways

The children will be learning about rivers and identifying features of a river. They will study local rivers and hopefully visit a local brook to do some field work.
