

### Health and Relationships: Keeping Safe

- Safety and responsibility with medicine use
- How we can stay safe and who we can ask for help
- Identify situations in which they would need to say 'Yes', 'No', 'I'll ask', or 'I'll tell',
- Explore wanted and unwanted touch
- Identify safe and unsafe secrets

### Literacy: Grandad's Camper

A young girl visits her grandfather by the sea, where he reminisces about the adventures he and his late husband, Gramps, used to take in their camper van.

- Write statements, questions, exclamations, commands
  - Use subordination (because, when)
  - Use present and past tenses correctly and consistently (some progressive).
- Use punctuation correctly - exclamation marks, question marks
- Y3: Also - adverbs of time, inverted commas, consistent past and present tense

### Maths: Y2

#### Money:

- Recognise, count and compare pounds and pence
  - Calculate with money and find change
- Multiplication and division:
  - Recognise, make and add equal groups
    - Use arrays
    - Double and half numbers
  - Recognise odd and even numbers

### Maths: Y3

#### Money:

- As Year 2, along with converting pound and pence
  - Multiples of 2,5,10,3,4,8
- Written methods for multiplication and division

### PE - Value is Sportspersonship

**Indoor athletics:** Basic technique for jumping for distance and height; to develop awareness of and use effective running technique; to throw with accuracy and power.

**Net/ wall games:** Children will develop their hand eye coordination; to develop and improve racket skills; to hit with control.

### Art: Sculpture

Children will model and carve clay to replicate natural materials such as stones, bones, teeth and shells. Children will create different patterns and textures through pinching and carving.

### Music

#### Zoo Time

### RE: Christianity

Why is the Bible a special book for humans? Children will learn that the Bible is the biggest selling book in the world. They will learn they Bible is split into the Old and New Testaments and it contains parables, which contain meanings.

### Geography: Our World

Children will be learn about hot and cold areas of the world in relation to the Equator. They will learn about different human and physical geographical features and learn about compass points and directional language.

### Science: Rocks and Fossils

Children will learn about Sedimentary, Igneous and Metamorphic rocks. They will learn how fossils are formed and what soil is made from.

### French: Animals

Children will learn nouns of animals and will learn how to say which animals they have or like.

### Computing: Programming

Children will learn and explore programming Bee-Bots; they will design their own maps and create their own algorithms to guide the BeeBot. They will learn how to debug their algorithms where needed.
