

## Literacy

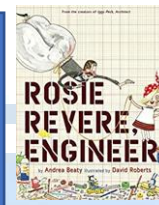
We will be looking at a fictional story called 'Silly Doggy' by Adam Stower.

Kingsley journal books will be kept in school on a Thursday and will be returned on the Friday.

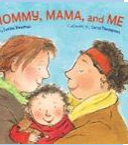
## Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Through our Coram programme the children will be learning...

- I can show resilient and confidence in my learning.
- I can name and discuss different types of feelings and emotions.
- I can make healthy choices.
- I can name and recognise how healthy choices can keep us well.

## Maths

Through our Mastering Number program, the children will:

- Compare sets and use language of comparison: more than, fewer than, an equal number to make unequal sets equal
- Focus on the 'staircase' pattern and ordering numbers
- Focus on ordering of numbers to 8 Use language of less than
- Focus on ordering of numbers to 8 Use language of less than
- Focus on 7

For Shape, Space and Measure, the children will be focusing on:

- 3D shapes and beginning to name their properties.

## Physical Development

Throughout the day and in our PE lessons the children will learn...

Running can be done at different speeds.

Running can happen in a straight line.

Jumping uses bent knees and feet together to help movement and balance.

Jumping can move the body forwards over a distance.

Objects can be released or thrown towards another object.

Aiming towards a target can help an object reach where it is intended to go.

## Understanding of the World

In Religious Education the children will learn...

- I can talk about my own experience of a church or my family members' experience using photographs.
- A church is a Christians place of worship
- In church Christians show love, respect and thanks to God through singing, praying, listening to stories and through actions such as lighting candle.
- The Bible is a special book for Christians which contains lots of stories.
- Christians believe the stories teach them about God, how to be kind and make the right choices.
- A Christian's place of worship is called a Church but other religions have their own special place that they worship in.

## Expressive Arts and Design

In Expressive Art and Design, we will be learning about painting. The children will be looking at the artist Marney Ward

- Knows that a variety of tools and materials, including brushes, sponges, and other resources, can be used to create different effects in art.
- Knows and can identify the primary colours.
- Understands that colours can be matched to objects and observed in the environment.
- Knows that paint can be explored in different ways and on a range of surfaces, including different colours, sizes, and shapes of paper.
- Understands that adding white paint can lighten a colour and adding black paint can darken a colour.
- Knows that a sketchbook can be used to record and collect simple ideas, explorations, and media experiments.

## Understanding the World

The children will be learning...

- In the UK we experience rain, snow, wind, sun, clouds
- In autumn, it is starting to feel cooler with wind and cloudy weather.
- In winter we see rain and wind and it feels cold.
- In spring, we see rain and some sunny days.
- In summer, we see sun and the weather is warmer.
- We need to wear different clothes in the seasons.
- The weathers can change your emotions.
