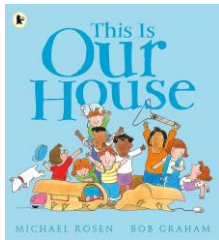


Literacy

We will be looking at the story 'This is our house' by Michael Rosen

The children will be able to...

- To talk about the characters and setting in a story.
- To use language directly from familiar stories.
- To hear the initial sounds of words.
- To use some print and marks in my early writing.
- To form some familiar letter shapes.
- To write some or all of the letters from my name.
- To begin to hold my pen using a tripod grip



Maths

Through practical games and activities to the children will be able to...

- To recall that the last number reached when counting a small set of objects tells me how many there are in total
- To show 'finger numbers' up to 5.
- To continue a numerical pattern.
- To experiment with my own symbols and marks as well as numerals.
- To talk about and explore 2D and 3D shapes
- To compare quantities using language: 'more than', 'fewer than'.

Understanding of the World

In this unit the children will learn...

- To talk about Mother's Day is always on a Sunday.
- To know Christians celebrate Jesus' life during Easter.
- To know that Christians believe Jesus died during Easter.

In this unit the children will explore...

- How the environment changes from winter to spring.
- Using our senses, what we can see, feel and hear in spring.
- Animals that are born in spring.

In our water unit, the children will explore...

- What objects float and sink.
- How we can make objects float.
