- Recap previously taught keys from this year that we can apply to our writing, including subordination and fronted adverbials

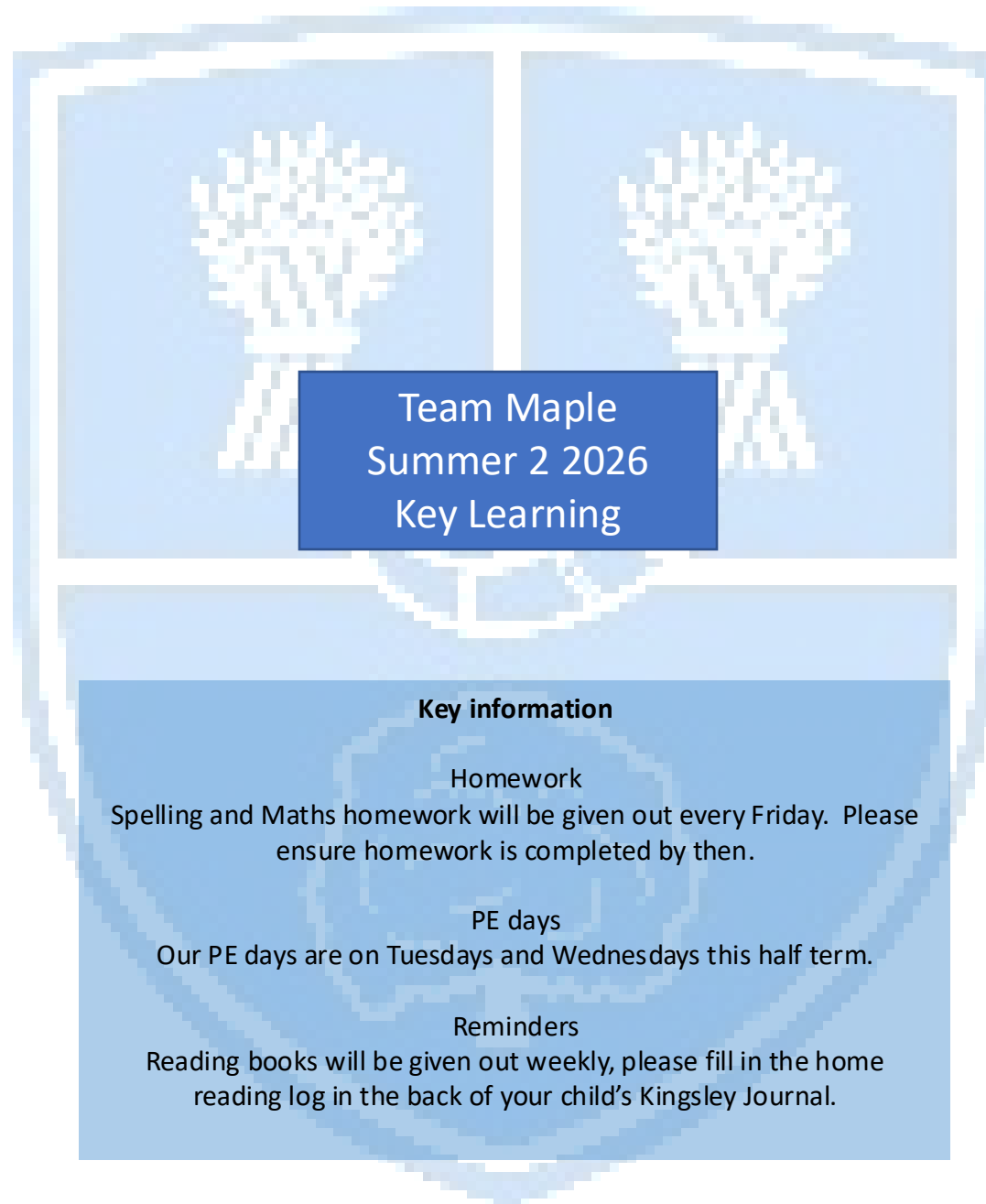
Maths

Decimals and Money

The children will be dividing 1 and 2-digit numbers by 10 and 100, understanding the place value columns to include tenths and hundredths. We will then use our knowledge of decimals and apply this to money.

Shape & Position and Direction

The children will learn the properties of triangles, quadrilaterals and polygons before plotting coordinates and translating shapes on a grid.
