Ibn Battuta	 Born in Morocco, North Africa in 1304. He travelled further than any other explorer of his time. He wrote a book about his travels which tells us what many parts of the world were like nearly 700 years ago. 	
Captain Cook	 Born in Yorkshire in 1728. He made 3 voyages to the Pacific Ocean, mapping and recording several islands and coastlines on maps for the first time. 	
Roald Amundsen	 One of the greatest Polar explorers. He was the first explorer to reach the South Pole. He was the first explorer to fly over the North Pole in an airship. 	
Captain Robert Falcon Scott	 Antarctic explorer. He was beaten to the South Pole by just 5 weeks by Roald Amundsen. 	
Sunita Williams	 An American astronaut. Her 2 flights to the International Space Station combined lasted 321 days. She is ranked 2nd for the most time spent in space by a woman.
