Literacy: Look Up!

It follows a science-obsessed young girl named Rocket who is determined to become an astronaut.

- Use full stops and capital letters correctly
- Use expanded noun phrases to describe and specify
 - Use coordination (and)
 - Use subordination (because)

Maths: Y2

Place value:

- Partition, write, compare, order numbers to 100
- Show confident understanding of tens and ones
 - Place numbers to 100 on a number line

Addition and subtraction

- Fact families
- Number bonds to 100 (tens)
 - Add and subtract 1s
 - Add by making 10

PE – Value is Perseverance

Body management: Children will be developing their ability to hold different balance positions with tension. Children will learning how to link movements to create a sequence.

Games (object control): Children will be developing their confidence and skill with controlling an object that is coming towards them.

Art: Drawing unit

Children will be using pen to develop and refine their drawing technique from last year. The focus will be on drawing a rocket and will be using different hatching, stippling and shading techniques, this time working with the permanence of pen.

Geography: The countries of the UK

Children will learn the names of different properties, along with their properties. They will explore how these properties make certain materials more suitable for some objects than others.
