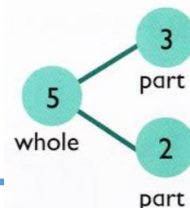


We are going to read *Shackleton's Journey*, some short stories about survivors and *Windrush Child* by Benjamin Zephaniah



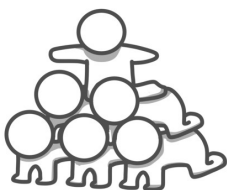
Maths

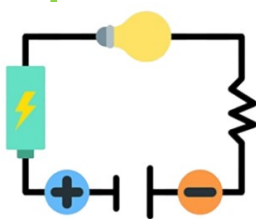

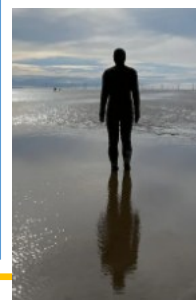
Science

We will be working on sculptures using Anthony Gormley and Gaudi as our stimulus.



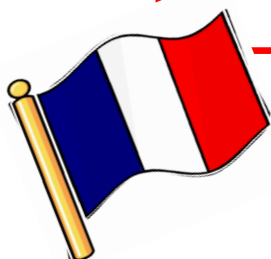
