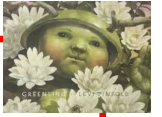


Year 6 Spring 1 Overview



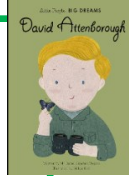
Writing

We will be writing in different levels of formality about environmental issues and using the book 'Greenling' to explore writing from different points of view.

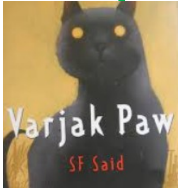


Reading

We will be reading about famous figures and their inspirational achievements.

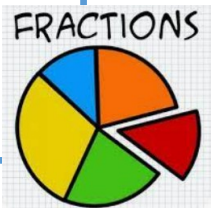


We will also be reading the novel *Varjak Paw* by SF Said.

We will be looking at number lines, how to round numbers, calculate the mean average of a set of numbers and the order of operations (BODMAS)



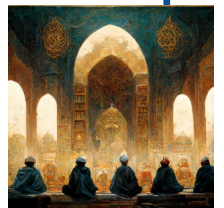
P.E

(Early Islamic civilisation)



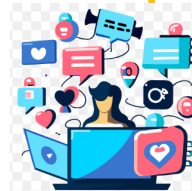

Is it better to express your religion in Arts and Architecture or Charity and Generosity?



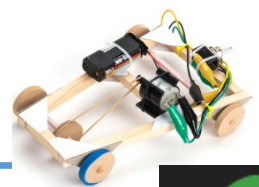

We will be reflecting on how the media can influence and affect people.



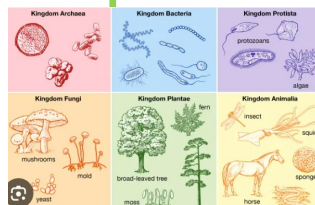
