We have given you 10 activities to choose from and would like you to complete any 7 of these over Autumn 1. We are sure that you will put in a lot of effort for each piece of homework and you will enjoy presenting your homework to the rest of the class, sharing all of your hard work. Each activity is worth a different amount of Dojo points. As you complete the activities, please bring your homework into school- one task per week.

Compulsory tasks:

Reading 15-20 minutes every day.

Times tables based on the weekly test which will take place each week.

Spellings based on the test which will take place every Friday.

<p><u>Creativity (Art)</u></p> <p>Design a stone age outfit. Think about the materials that it would be made from. Don't forget to label your design!</p>  <p>3 Dojo points.</p>	<p><u>Music</u></p> <p>Find out 5 facts about your instrument or someone famous that plays your instrument.</p>  <p>2 Dojo points.</p>	<p><u>Model making/sculpting</u></p> <p>Practise the running stitch using a needle and thread.</p>  <p>5 Dojo points.</p>	<p><u>What if? (History)</u></p> <p>Draw a typical person living in the stone age. Think about their clothes, what they would eat and where they would live.</p> <p>2 Dojo points.</p>	<p><u>Research (Science)</u></p> <p>Find a rock and turn it into a pet, you can even give it a name! Use your homework book to describe it. Is it an igneous, metamorphic or sedimentary rock? Try to use what we have learned in class to help you!</p>  <p>5 Dojo points.</p>
<p><u>Story time (English)</u></p> <p>Pretend you are the Stone Age Boy or Girl. Write a diary entry as if you were that child.</p> <p>5 Dojo points.</p>	<p><u>PE</u></p> <p>Create your own gymnastic sequence using more than 3 moves.</p> <p>2 Dojo points.</p>	<p><u>Puzzle creator (Maths)</u></p> <p>Create a board game that you can play with someone at home. The game must include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Odd and even numbers • Place value • Adding and subtracting <p>5 Dojo points.</p>	<p><u>Geography</u></p> <p>Find a historical landmark in Stockport and draw it in your homework book.</p> <p>3 Dojo points.</p>	<p><u>Take a trip (PSHE)</u></p> <p>Go for a walk in the local area. Find something that interests you and write about it in your homework book. You can send a picture to your teacher on Dojo.</p> <p>4 Dojo points.</p>
