What we will be learning this half term...

English

This half term we will be reading 'The Whale' by Ethan and Vita Murrow. We will be writing our own version of the story and also using the book as a stimulus to create a newspaper report. In **Guided Reading**, we will continue to work through our reading 'gems' using texts linked to our topic work and also our Author of the Term, Dick King-Smith.

Maths

<u>Place Value</u> – representing and partitioning numbers to 1000, ordering and comparing numbers to 1000, using a number line and estimating, rounding, using Roman numerals

<u>Addition & Subtraction</u> – adding and subtracting 4-digit numbers without exchanging, adding and subtracting 4-digit number with exchange, estimating and checking strategies

Science - Sound

RE - Key Question: What Do Christians Learn from the Creation Story?

ICT - Coding, Online Safety, Using Spreadsheets

History - Anglo Saxon Arts & Culture

PE

Dodgeball (Wednesday afternoons) Swimming (Thursday mornings)

Music - 'Mamma Mia', by ABBA - Listen & Appraise, Play, Improvise, Compose, Sing

Art - Focus Artist: Kate O'Brien, Mixed-media landscapes
