What we will be learning this half term...

English

This term we are reading a beautiful picture book called 'Leaf' by Sandra Dieckmann. In the story a polar bear finds his way to an unknown land. We will be using this text to inspire our own story writing and, later in the half term, to write information texts about polar animals.

In Guided Reading, we will continue to rehearse our reading skills of inference, definition, summarise, relate, compare and predict. Our author of the term is Dick King-Smith.

Maths

Area: calculating and comparing areas of shapes

Multiplication and Division: the 3, 6, and 9 times tables, related division facts, the 7, 11 and 12 times table, multiplying 3 numbers

Science – Animals, Including Humans

Geography – Our World: Europe
