

Focus Books/Stories:

We share books daily in the EYFS however there are some key texts that will guide our learning and group time sessions.

The books this half term are:

- The Billy Goats Gruff (Thinking and Finding Out)
- The Something (Literacy)

Maths Focus:

- Match, sort and compare
- Talk about measure and patterns
- Saying numbers in order to 10 (2+3=5)



How to help at home:

- *Share this Talk and Learn sheet with your child. Talk about the staff and use their names. Encourage your child follow our classroom rules, you may want to use the same phrases at home too.
- *Sing our focus songs and our number rhyme, encourage your child to join in with the repetitive phrases and follow the beat of the songs. When singing the number song can they talk about what is happened to the number of bears?
- *Book bags- if you have not already, please provide your child with a book bag and bring it to school each day
- *Drop off- encourage your child to be independent in the morning, let them find their own tray and put their book bag away.
- *Complete the Talking Time activities and share the library book that your child chooses to bring home.
