Spring Term 1 root value - Resilience

What we will be learning this half term...

- **English** – This half term we are reading the story Arthur and the Golden Rope. This is a book based on the Norse myths told by the Vikings and links well with our History work. The children will be writing their own myths and, later in the term, an information guide to explain how to catch a mythical monster! We have a new author of the term for the Spring, Cressida Cowell. Cowell is the author of the How to Train Your Dragon books, which you may wish to recommend to your child for further reading at home.
- **Maths**
Multiplication and Division: factors and factor pairs, multiplying and dividing a 2 or 3 digit number by a single digit number
Length and Perimeter: measuring in m and km, perimeters of grids and rectangles, finding the missing length, perimeters of regular polygons.
- **Science – Electricity**
- **RE** – Key Question: *How Do People from Religious and Non-Religious Communities Celebrate Key Festivals?*
- **Computing** – Touch Typing, Email, Databases
- **History** – Here Come the Vikings!
- **PE** – Gymnastics in the hall, Hockey outside on the yard
- **Music** – Wider Opps band on Fridays (Brass bad tuition), Charanga Unit 3 – Stop!
- **DT** – Levers and Linkages
- **PSHE** – Keeping Myself Safe

How you can support your child's learning at home...

By the end of Year 4, the children must know all of their times tables up to 12x12. Therefore, it is very important that they spend time at home revising their tables. 'TTRockstars' is a great way to do this! Please ask if your child does not have a login. We recommend 15 minutes 3 times a week.
