- One-form entry primary school
- Approximately 210 pupils
- Seven classes (Reception to Year 6)
- Class size: up to 30 pupils

The School Day

- Gates open: 8:40am
- School starts: 8:50am

We also offer wraparound care:

- Breakfast club: from 7:45am
- After-school care: until 5:45pm
- Provided by S4YC and based predominantly in the school hall

Lunchtime

- Healthy school meals cooked on site
- Option to bring a packed lunch should you wish
- Special themed lunch days throughout the year
