

English

Class text: Oliver and the Seawigs by Philip Reeve and Sarah McIntyre.

This English sequence will see us explore Oliver's journey in search of his missing parents. We will be exploring the story and its experiences through role play and through writing in role. We will also be writing stories from another character's point of view based on the story that has been read

Science - Sound

We will be learning all about sound. We will explore ways to change the pitch of a sound, and ways to absorb sound. To finish up, we will make a musical instrument to demonstrate our knowledge of sound.

Computing

We will be creating media and photo editing. We will be looking at cropping, rotating and retouching images. We will also explore what makes an image real or made up.

French

We will be learning all about musical instruments in French this half term. We will apply this new knowledge into listening, speaking and written exercises.

Music

We will be looking at exploring feelings when we play. Our social question we will be exploring is, how does music connect us with our past?

RE

We are going to be exploring the significance of the Nativity Story for Christians. Our key enquiry question: What is the most significant part of the Nativity Story for Christians today?

Maths-Addition and subtraction

Y3 - To add and subtract mentally and formally up to 3 digit numbers. Solve problems.

Y4 - To add and subtract up to 4 digit numbers using formal methods. Solve problems.

Multiplication and division

Y3 - recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4 and 8 multiplication tables.

Y4 - recall multiplication and division facts for multiplication tables up to 12×12 .

History - Ancient Greece

We will be discovering all about Ancient Greece and its impact on the wider world. We will look at Alexander the Great, Greek Gods and Goddesses, Olympics and of course the Trojan Horse story.

DT

For DT this half term we will be making bread. We will be analysing different breads and how they are made. Following this we will design, make and evaluate our own bread.

PSHE

For PSHE this half term we will be looking at how we can be our best. Our focus will be looking at positive choices for our physical and mental health.
