We will be reading the following texts:



A writer's knowledge organiser:

We will be applying all the skills we have learnt in year 4 to write for different audiences and purposes.



A mathematician's knowledge organiser:

We will learn about angles and how to compare and order them. We will also revisit and build on our knowledge of shape and lines of symmetry.



A scientist's knowledge organiser: Sound.

We will learn that sounds are made when objects vibrate. This makes the **air** around the object **vibrate** and the **air vibrations** then **travel** to and enter your **ear**.



We will learn that objects that create slower vibrations create deeper pitched sounds and that objects that create **faster**

vibrations create deeper pitched sounds



An artist's knowledge organiser: Painting.

We will identify, mix and use warm and cold colours. We will create flat and variegated washes using warm and cold colours. We will then use this knowledge to create a land-scape painting.



A musician's knowledge organiser:

We will learn about the history and features of Calypso music, performing a calypso style song with our voices and tuned percussion.





An athlete's knowledge organiser: We will be learning and playing rounders and cricket. We will continue to practise and improve our throwing and catching skills and will also learn to bat and bowl.





A knowledge organiser for Religious Education: In RE, we will be beginning to learn about what it means to be a Hindu in Britain today.



A linguist's knowledge organiser: In French, we will be learning to talk about the weather.



A citizen's knowledge organiser for Personal Education: We will be learning how to answer the following questions. What does it mean to be confidential (secretive)? Why might someone ask you to keep a secret or be confidential? When is it ok to break a confidence (or share a secret)? What are the main stages of the human lifecycle? What is puberty? What physical and emotional changes happen in puberty? What changes occur between childhood and adulthood that can lead to reproduction? What does it mean to be respectful? Why is it important to be respectful even when online? How can friendships make people feel unhappy or uncomfortable? We will be learning the meaning of the following words: puberty, life cycle, reproduction, physical, pregnancy, breasts, sperm, egg, pubic hair, emotions and feelings.
