
A mathematician's knowledge organiser:

We will be exploring addition and subtraction within 10 and writing the number sentences. For example:






To know place value within 20



To know 3D shapes and their properties.



A scientist's knowledge organiser:

Materials and their Properties

We will be distinguishing between an object and the material from which it is made.

We will be discovering and describing the properties of different materials e.g. waterproof, transparent, opaque etc.





We will be looking at recycling and how we can reduce waste.

A computing specialist's knowledge organiser:

To know how to record sounds and pictures on a computer







A historian knowledge organiser:

We will be learning about the historical event 'The Gunpowder Plot' and why it happened on the 5th November 1605.





We will be comparing toys now to toys from the past.

We will talk about what toys are made from and how the materials have changed over time.



An artist's knowledge organiser:

We will be learning how to create our own patterns using different graded pencils.

To know that a pattern is a repeated decorative design where lines, shapes and forms are repeated.

We will be creating a Christmas card for our family, using the learnt about creating patterns using different graded pencils.



A musician's knowledge organiser:

We will be learning about the speed of music: Tempo

We will be learning that dynamics means how loud or soft a piece of music is.

We will be exploring sounds to support our story telling.

We will be performing songs for our families in our year 1 Christmas Production.

We will be linking movements together to create a sequence to share with our friends, linked to a firework theme.


We will use gymnastic equipment to travel across, jump off and land safely.

Ca Va? (How are you?)


Merci (thank you)
