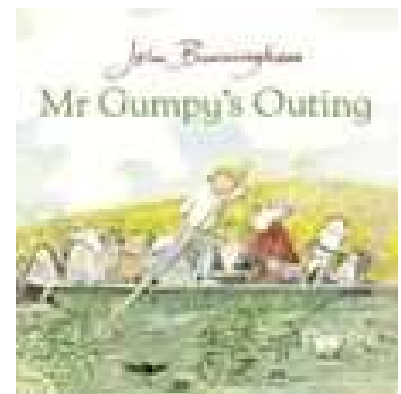
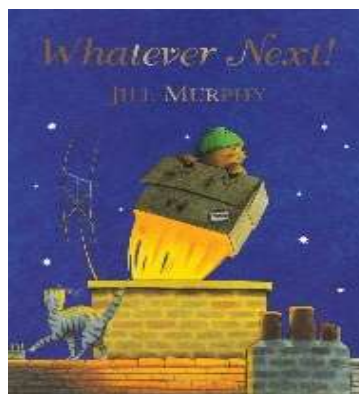
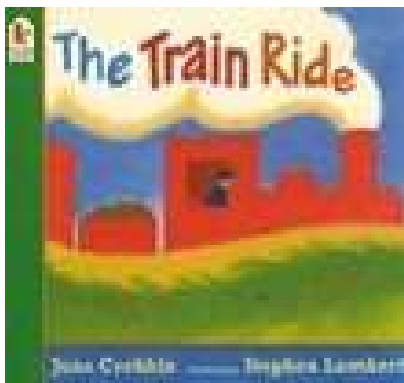

**A Writer's Knowledge Organiser:**

- To be able to correctly read and write tricky words linked to the Little Wandle scheme.
- To blend short words and read them with greater fluency.
- To read familiar books to build confidence, fluency and word recognition.
- To read simple sentences and phrases.
