## Uniform and PE Kit

Children will be receiving SATs revision books for Reading, Maths and SPaG. Homework will be set linked to learning in class.

Spellings will be set and tested every week on Fridays. Please ensure your child practises at home.

Children should be reading independently, or to someone, for at least 20 minutes a day. Children can quiz when they have finished their book.
