Uniform and PE Kit

White shirt and Havannah tie, sweatshirt/cardigan, dark trousers/skirts, sensible shoes.

Our P.E lesson is on a Friday morning; the children need to come into school wearing their full P.E kit on this day. This includes blue shorts and white t-shirt, pumps or bare feet for indoor games, trainers or pumps for outdoor games, tracksuit bottoms can be worn during winter outside.

If your child has a sports club on a different day, then their PE kit must be brought with them in a bag to get changed into after school.

For safety reasons, jewellery should not be worn during any P.E. sessions (recently pierced ears must be covered by tape).

Year 1 Curriculum

We will be following the Year 1 Power Maths curriculum, alongside NCETM mastering number sessions.

In reading, we follow the Read Write Inc scheme and writing, Ready Steady Write. These are linked to topics and rich texts.

Throughout the year, we learn about:

- Where we live: Congleton
- Entertainment and Buildings
- People who changed the world.

These topics shape our curriculum in all areas to create pertinent links in the children's learning.

Homework

Read Write Inc reading books will be sent home weekly. Your child will bring home a copy of the text we have been reading in school, an enrichment book for you to read to them and a bookbag book. Please sign your child's Reading Record each time they read. Books will be changed every Friday. Reading is a big focus in year 1! Please listen to your child read as often as you can and work on the set 1, 2 and 3 sounds with them.

Challenges may be set on ClassDojo intermittently throughout the year.

Class Behaviour System

In Year 1 we follow the whole school behaviour policy of numbered levels. We praise positive behaviours to promote desired behaviours to all pupils. We have a class recognition board to celebrate pupils hard work and successes. In addition, weekly celebration certificates are handed out on Friday during our whole school celebration assembly.
