Curriculum and Homework

● Book changing will take place every Friday, please ensure you return your child's books ready for them to be changed.

● Phonics will be a big focus this year in preparation for the Phonics screening check towards the end of Year 1. If you don't have a lot of time to do homework with your child and you can only do one thing, please listen to them read and go through the Set 1, 2 and 3 sounds with them.

Key information:

- Label your child's clothing, water bottle, bag and coat.
- Please ensure your child comes into school with a drink and snack for morning break daily. Free fruit is available for afternoon break.
- Order your child's lunches via Scopay with them at home.
- PE- Friday morning. I will be out of the classroom for my planning time.
- Forest school- Thursday afternoon (once every three weeks). (Labelled bag- change of clothes, waterproofs and wellies). (Come into school wearing old clothes).
- Check our Class Dojo story to stay up to date with what is happening in Year 1 and any key information.
