Dear Parents and Carers,

In Year 6 children are given the opportunity to participate in an annual residential. Next year we will be taking children to the YHA in Malham where they will explore the fabulous terrain that is Malham Cove (as seen in the Harry Potter film - <u>https://www.malhamdale.com/harry-potter-malham-cove/</u>). We will also walk the Ingleton Waterfall trail (<u>https://www.ingletonwaterfallstrail.co.uk/</u>), as well as completing other team building activities. It is wonderful for our children to experience the great outdoors and they will all benefit enormously from the experience, both educationally and socially. Last year's residential to Malham was a huge success and much enjoyed by all.

This amazing opportunity is only possible thanks to the generosity of spirit of staff who freely give up their weekend to accompany and care for the children 24/7. It is, therefore, essential that children who attend have demonstrated that they can follow instructions safely and quickly. As such, if your child's behaviour causes concern in school they may not be able to attend the residential, even if money has been paid.

The cost of the holiday includes travel between the school and Malham, full board accommodation at the YHA (<u>https://www.yha.org.uk/hostel/yha-malham</u>) and a packed programme of activities, plus refreshments. Also included in the price is the entrance to the Ingleton Waterfalls trail where we will complete an amazing walk alongside a river. The total cost will be **£195.00** per child.

To support parents and carers we are extending the payment plan for the Year 6 residential. A suggested plan is attached; however, it is the payment dates in bold which must be met. You can pay online using your credit or debit card through our new School Money system or send either send cash or a cheque made payable to Hatton Hill S F Account. A full payment plan can also be found on your School Money account. If you feel you will struggle to meet the cost of the residential, please make an appointment to talk with Mrs James in confidence.

To secure you child's place a payment of £40.00 must be paid by Friday, 29th September 2023.
