How can I replicate Tinga Tinga Artwork?

Objectives

- To know the history of African Tingatinga art, including the influence of tourism.
- To be familiar with the original work of Edward Saidi Tingatinga and compare with modern art.
- To observe Tanzanian artists painting in the Tingatinga style, observing how bold colours and pattern.
- To develop technique: through teaching and experimentation with different painting techniques, they develop control of the medium. Knowing which technique is most appropriate to the Tingatinga style.
- Use sketchbooks to experiment with the medium and to design an image in the style of Tingatinga.
- To improve mastery by producing a painting in the style of Tingatinga demonstrating clear understanding of the design influences and key elements of this style.
