Year 2 supports growing independence by helping pupils understand difference, cooperation and managing worries, while also beginning to navigate everyday risks. Through strand one, pupils explore how relationships and families vary. Within strand two, pupils explore how to stay safe in person and online. Finally, in strand three, pupils begin to think about their futures and learn how healthy routines and simple decision making can influence their wellbeing. This prepares pupils for the increased responsibility of KS2.
