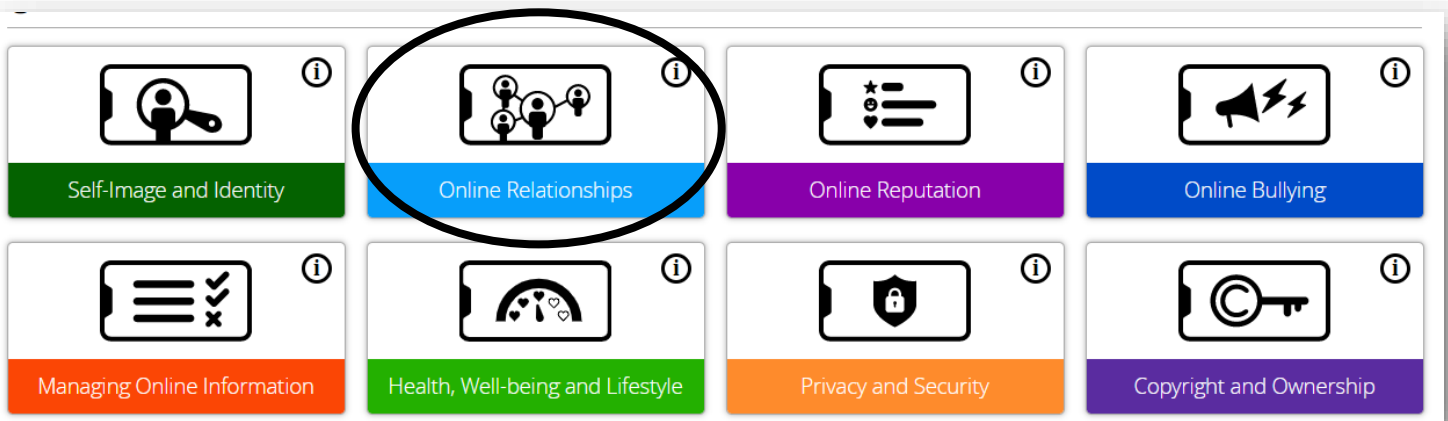
Online Safety



National Curriculum: use technology safely and respectfully, keeping personal information private; identify where to go for help and support when they have concerns about content or contact on the internet or other online technologies.

Strand: Online Relationships

Intent: I can explain how someone's feelings can be hurt by what is said or written online. I can explain the importance of giving and gaining permission before sharing things online; how the principles of sharing online is the same as sharing offline e.g. sharing images and videos.

Intents	Student
Can I give examples of how someone might use technology to communicate with others they don't also know offline and explain why this might be risky?	
Can I explain who I should ask before sharing things about myself or others online?	
Can I describe different ways to ask for, give, or deny my permission online and can identify who can help me if I am not sure?	
Can I explain why I have a right to say 'no' or 'I will have to ask someone'? Can I explain who can help me if I feel under pressure to agree to something I am unsure about or don't want to do?	
Can I identify who can help me if something happens online without my consent?	
Can I explain how it may make others feel if I do not ask their permission or ignore their answers before sharing something about them online?	
Can I explain why I should always ask a trusted adult before clicking 'yes', 'agree' or 'accept' online?
