Exploring an Ambulance!

On Wednesday, we were visited by Sam the Paramedic, who arrived in his ambulance! He spent time with us as a whole class, answering our questions and telling us all about his role as a paramedic. We then had the chance to explore the ambulance in small groups.

Sam talked us through all the equipment inside the ambulance, and we couldn't believe just how much equipment it can hold! He explained how some of the equipment is used, and we even got to check our heart rate on the monitor. Sam also showed us the bag they carry when visiting a patient – we were amazed by how heavy it was! We learned that ambulances have special lights that help paramedics find people's veins, and we loved being lit up blue while searching for our own veins. Finally, we had the opportunity to sit in the driver's seat, where Sam explained what all the buttons do – and we even got to turn on the flashing lights! We send a heartfelt thank you to Sam for spending the morning with us and teaching us so much about his important job.

Maths – Weighing

In one of our Maths topics this week, we explored weighing. We used balancing scales to find objects that weigh the same, using mathematical vocabulary such as 'equal', as well as identifying objects that were heavier and lighter. The children were excellent at using their mathematical vocabulary to compare the weight of different objects.

Toothbrushing Day

On Tuesday next week, we would like the children to bring in their toothbrush and toothpaste, both clearly named and in a sealed bag (a sandwich bag will be perfect).
