<p><b>Music</b></p> <p>Using GarageBand or another music app, create a piece of music inspired by <b>South American music styles</b>, thinking about <b>rhythm, tempo and percussion</b>.</p>	<p><b>English / Geography</b></p> <p>Design and write a <b>postcard from the Amazon Rainforest</b>, describing what you can see, hear and feel.</p>	<p><b>Science</b></p> <p>Research a <b>naturalist</b> (for example <b>Jane Goodall, David Attenborough or Rachel Carson</b>) and write a <b>biography</b> explaining their work and why it is important.</p>	<p><b>Art</b></p> <p>Create a <b>rainforest model or painting</b>, showing the <b>rainforest layers</b> (forest floor, understory, canopy and emergent layer) and <b>animals that live there</b>.</p>
<p><b>English / Geography / Science</b></p> <p>Create a <b>fact file about a rainforest animal</b>, including its <b>habitat, diet and life cycle</b>.</p>	<p><b>Maths</b></p> <p>Use the <b>free MathsBot website</b> to practise your <b>KS2 arithmetic skills</b>. The easiest way is to Google <b>"MathsBot arithmetic Year 5"</b> (or choose a lower year group if you would like extra practice at a different level of challenge).</p>	<p><b>Geography</b></p> <p>Create a <b>labelled map of South America</b> showing at least five countries, the <b>Amazon Rainforest</b> and the <b>Andes mountains</b>.</p>	<p><b>Geography / English</b></p> <p>Design a <b>travel brochure for a South American country</b>, including climate, landmarks, wildlife and interesting facts.</p>
<p><b>Science</b></p> <p>Grow a <b>plant from a seed or bulb</b> and record what happens over time.</p>	<p><b>English / Art</b></p> <p>Draw a <b>4-panel comic strip</b> where <b>two rainforest animals work together to solve a problem</b>.</p> <p>Think about <b>what challenge they face</b> and <b>how they help each other</b>.</p>	<p><b>Maths (daily life skills)</b></p> <p>Practise <b>reading the time on an analogue clock</b> as many times as you can over the next few weeks.</p> <p>Write down the <b>times you practised (using am/pm or 24-hour time)</b> and note what you were doing at those times.</p>	<p><b>Music / Art</b></p> <p>Listen to <b>Octopus's Garden by The Beatles</b> and create a piece of <b>underwater artwork inspired by the song</b>.</p> <p>Then write a <b>short descriptive paragraph</b> explaining what is happening in your picture and how the music inspired your ideas.</p>
<p><b>English</b></p> <p>Practise your <b>handwriting</b> by copying out a favourite poem, song lyrics, short extract or a page from a book neatly.</p>	<p><b>PSHE</b></p> <p>Whilst listening to some of your favourite songs, <b>draw a picture of yourself</b> and add words around it that describe your <b>strengths, talents and best qualities</b>.</p>	<p><b>English</b></p> <p>Create a <b>word search or crossword puzzle</b> using words that represent your life for someone else to complete.</p>	<p><b>PE / PSHE</b></p> <p>Invent a <b>new playground game</b> and write instructions explaining how to play.</p>
