Maths Focus – Weighing

Ask your child to count out 6, 7 or 8 small objects (e.g. toys, pasta or socks) from a larger group. Encourage them to show the number on their fingers as "5 and a bit" and tell you how they know they have the correct amount.

Before planting, we found out what plants need to grow — light, water, soil and carbon dioxide (yes, we even learned what carbon dioxide is!). We are very excited to watch them grow over the coming weeks.

This half term, we will also be exploring sculpture. We began by using mud as our media — it certainly got very messy, but we had lots of fun moulding and manipulating the mud into different shapes.
