This week has been full of discovery, excitement, and some special visitors!

We continued our learning about British birds and spent time outside hanging up our homemade bird food. We were thrilled to see that it's already attracting some feathered friends to our garden! The children learned about the lifecycle of a robin and explored new vocabulary such as *hatched* and *fledgling*.

Our book of the week was '*Gozzle*' by *Julia Donaldson*, which follows a baby gosling from egg to adulthood. The story sparked lots of thoughtful conversations about growing, and how living things change over time.

We also had a very exciting visit from a paramedic, who arrived in a real ambulance! The children loved looking inside, learning about the equipment, and hearing what each item is used for. One of the highlights was getting the chance to sit in the driver's seat – a truly memorable experience for everyone.

In addition, some of the children explored a special box kindly left by the fire service. Inside was firefighter dress-up clothing, a large wooden fire engine, a selection of books, and real smoke alarms to investigate and test. This led to important discussions about fire safety, emergencies, and how, when, and who to call for help.

It's been a busy and enriching week full of hands-on learning and real-world experiences.
