Dear Families,

We have had another busy and exciting week at preschool as we continued our Spring learning.

The children watched short video clips showing what Britain looks like in the springtime and we explored the question: **“What is the weather like in Spring?”** This week’s weather gave us a perfect opportunity to see just how *mixed* spring weather can be! We talked about sunshine, rain, wind and changing skies, and the children shared their own observations about the weather they noticed.

To help us investigate further, we made our own rain gauge using a clear plastic container so we can begin measuring how much rain falls. The children were interested in checking it and talking about how full it might get after rainy days.

We also created a wind streamer using a large stick and colourful ribbons chosen by the children. This has been a fantastic visual way to see how strong the wind is in our outdoor area. With the strong winds we had this week, the streamer certainly had lots of use!

In the creative area, the children enjoyed observational drawings of spring flowers such as daffodils and tulips. They looked carefully at the shapes and colours while drawing what they could see.

Outdoors, we have been strengthening our fine motor skills by using water spray bottles. The children had lots of fun spraying water while also developing hand strength and control.

Finally, the children have been working very hard on something top secret ready for this coming Sunday... so keep an eye out for a special surprise for Mothering Sunday.
