Use descriptive language and dialogue.</p>	<p><b>DT</b></p> <p><b>Design a Greek Temple:</b> Create a drawing or model of a Greek temple, labelling features such as <b>columns, steps and pediment</b>.</p>	<p><b>Science</b></p> <p><b>Athlete Investigation:</b> Investigate how exercise affects the body. Record your pulse before and after activity and present your results in a table or chart.</p>	<p><b>Geography</b></p> <p><b>Map of Greece:</b> Create a labelled map showing <b>Athens, Sparta, Mount Olympus, seas and islands</b>. Include key physical features.</p>
<p><b>Art</b></p> <p><b>Greek Pottery Design:</b> Design and decorate your own Ancient Greek vase pattern using traditional shapes, symbols and colours.</p>	<p><b>DT / Food Technology</b></p> <p><b>Greek Cooking at Home:</b> With an adult, make a simple Greek-inspired dish such as <b>tzatziki, Greek salad, flatbread or honey yoghurt</b>. If it's delicious, bring some in for Mr Price.</p>	<p><b>History</b></p> <p><b>Olympics:</b> Create a poster about the <b>Ancient Greek Olympics</b>, showing how they are similar to and different from the <b>modern Olympic Games</b>. Include <b>facts, pictures and key information</b>.</p>	<p><b>Maths</b></p> <p><b>World Cup Data Challenge:</b> Research the goals scored by five teams in the last World Cup tournament. Create a table or bar chart, then answer questions such as <i>Who scored the most? How many more? What is the total?</i></p>
<p><b>French</b></p> <p><b>Au Salon de Thé:</b> Create a simple <b>French café menu</b> with food, snacks and drinks labelled in French. Include prices in euros and practise ordering using key French phrases.</p>	<p><b>RE</b></p> <p><b>Guidance and Choices:</b> Create a short reflection or poster about <b>why it can sometimes be difficult to do the right thing</b> and what guides people in making choices.</p>	<p><b>Maths / Y6 preparation</b></p> <p>Use the <b>free MathsBot website</b> to practise your <b>KS2 arithmetic skills</b>. The easiest way is to Google <b>“MathsBot arithmetic Year 5”</b> (or choose a lower year group if you would like extra practice at a different level of challenge).</p>	<p><b>Computing</b></p> <p><b>Coding with Robocodo:</b> visit <b>Robocodo</b> online and complete some coding activities. Talk to an adult at home about <b>what you created and learned</b>.</p>
<p><b>PSHE</b></p> <p>Write about <b>what makes a good leader</b>, linking your ideas to democracy or leadership in Ancient Greece.</p>	<p><b>Wellbeing</b></p> <p><b>Get Active Outdoors:</b> Spend 20 minutes outside doing something active, such as walking, cycling, playing a game or exploring nature.</p>	<p><b>Science</b></p> <p><b>Space Challenge:</b> revisit your Earth and Space science skills from the autumn term by playing the BBC <b>Horrible Science: Stinky Space</b> Solar System game. Guide Pipette through space, avoid asteroids, and learn fun facts about the planets along the way.</p>	<p><b>PSHE</b></p> <p><b>Gratitude List:</b> Create a list of things you are thankful for and explain why they are important to you.</p>
