Ladybirds!

We've had some little visitors in Pre-School this week! We are extremely lucky to be looking after and watching ladybirds grow. We have looked at a ladybird's life cycle, chatting about the different stages and discussing the correct vocabulary. The ladybirds are currently in their 'larva' state and they will eventually go into their 'pupa' stage, to finally growing into adult ladybirds. We can't wait to watch them grow! The children have also been drawing and painting pictures of ladybirds and we have created a wonderful display. We also found out that a group of ladybirds is called a 'loveliness'.

Initial sounds

The children have been working really hard in Phonics this week, exploring initial sounds to words. We have been playing Kim's Game, identifying the missing objects that all begin with the same sound. The children have also been making up their own silly sentences, using words that begin with the same sound. One example the children came up with was "Rufus went in his rocket to eat some raspberries with a rabbit".

This week, our story is 'Maisy Learns to Swim'. We have been discussing what equipment we need when we go swimming and how we stay safe in the water.
