Sunshine

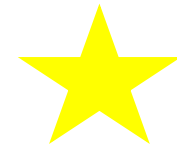
We have also been enjoying the glorious weather (albeit hot!) this week. We have been keeping cool during our water play, enjoying the sunshine and also spending some time in the shade too.
