Overview

The purpose of this policy is to outline the processes to ensure pupils with allergen and dietary requirements are catered for safely during school lunchtime.

Roles and Responsibilities

School office will provide the appropriate pupil allergen sheets which are displayed in the school kitchen by the serving hatch.

Meals are prepared at Antrobus St Marks Primary School and dispatched to Great Budworth. Meals for pupils with allergies or specific dietary requirements are dispatched in separate containers and labelled appropriately.

At Great Budworth meals are identified by the teaching assistant to the member of staff serving the school lunch, food is then served on purple plates/bowls with purple cutlery.

The purple plates and bowls are cleaned and stored separately in the school kitchen at Great Budworth.

In the case of a staff absence the school office will inform the member of staff serving meals who the pupils are with allergies or dietary requirements.
