### Earth and Space

#### Throughout the unit, the children will-

- Learn that the Earth, sun and moon are spherical bodies using secondary sources to present findings in oral and written forms.
- Describe the movement of the Earth and other planets relative to the Sun using diagrams and labels.
- Describe the movement of the moon using diagrams and labels.
- Explain why we have day and night using secondary sources to present findings in oral and written forms.
