Animals Including Humans

We are learning to:

- Describe the simple functions of the basic parts of the digestive system in humans.
- Identify the different types of teeth in humans and their simple functions.
- Construct and interpret a variety of food chains, identifying producers, predators and prey.

English

Maths

Decimals A

The children will build on their knowledge of fractions from year 3, investigating tenths and hundredths as fractions and decimals, through the use of place value charts and number lines. Pupils are also introduced to the concept of dividing 1- and 2- digit numbers by 10 and 100.

Decimals B

In this second decimals unit, the children will explore making a whole with tenths and with hundredths. We are also introduced to comparing and ordering decimals; rounding to the nearest whole number and recognising halves and quarters as decimals.

Money

The children will learn how to convert between pennies and pound using their knowledge of decimals.

French

We will focus on talking about our favourite animals, discuss our likes and dislikes and participate in conversation about animals we like. We will also begin to understand the function of a negative adverb and learn about subject pronouns and plural pronouns.

Music

In music we will begin to understand the inter-related dimensions of music and learn how to apply and use these to control sounds and create music. We will use graphic notations for tempo and dynamics to compose original music and rehearse, perform and evaluate an original composition.

Children will begin to think critically about the content we encounter in the digital world, including in the media. Focus is also given to online chatting and cyberbullying, and how to report and get help if children encounter inappropriate messages or material.

ART

Artist – Paul Cezanne

Inspired by the work of Paul Cezanne, the children will make an observational painting. The children will do this by using a photograph that they have taken of objects that they have positioned themselves.

Computing

Learners will develop their understanding of how digital images can be changed and edited, and how they can then be resaved and reused. They will consider the impact that editing images can have, and evaluate the effectiveness of their choices.
