#### **Electricity**

We will explore how electricity works and why it is so important for our lives today. We will construct simple electrical circuits and carry out some investigations to determine which materials conduct electricity and which are insulators of electricity.

### **English**

We will be learning to write a non-chronological report, diary and a narrative using fronted adverbials, prepositional phrases and expanded noun phrases.

### **Maths**

#### **Place Value**

We will look at numbers up to 10000 learning how to represent them using base 10, place value grids, place value counters and number lines.

We will learn how to use Roman numerals and begin to round numbers to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000.

#### **Addition and Subtraction**

We will use columns to add and subtract 4 digit numbers.

We will learn names of animals and how to describe what is in the garden.
