

# Year 1 Home Learning Spring 1

This half term, children are invited to complete a range of home learning tasks linked to the curriculum and the learning taking place in class. While you are welcome to complete as many tasks as you like, we ask that you complete at least three tasks across different subjects, for example, one English, one Maths, and one from another area of the curriculum.

**Home learning is due on Wednesday 11th February 2026, when children will have the opportunity to share their work with peers and teachers across the year group and receive feedback.**

Tasks can be completed in home learning exercise books or in any format you prefer.

Find <b>2 cards</b> . <b>Add or subtract</b> the numbers on the cards. <b>Write down your answers</b> and see if you notice any patterns.		<b>Geography - What is the weather like in the UK?</b> Look outside and check the weather each day for a week <b>Draw</b> a weather symbol for each day: ☀️ ☁️ ☔️ 🌨️ <b>Write</b> one sentence about the weather each day.
	<b>Write instructions to make a winter picture.</b> Write <b>3 simple steps</b> . Use words like <b>First, Next, Then</b> . Draw a picture to help your reader.		<b>Hopscotch Maths</b> Draw a <b>number line</b> on the floor or outside with chalk (1–20). <b>Hop to two numbers</b> and either <b>add or subtract them</b> . Say the answer out loud and then <b>write it down</b> .		<b>RE - Hinduism: Important Life Events</b> Choose a <b>Hindu festival</b> (e.g., Diwali) Draw a <b>picture of the festival</b> . Write <b>2–3 sentences</b> about why it is important.
	<b>Describing Winter</b> Look out of your window. Write <b>2–3 sentences</b> to describe winter. Use at least <b>one adjective</b> (describing word).		<b>Number Snap</b> Players take turns <b>turning over the top card</b> and placing it <b>in the middle</b> . When <b>two cards of the same number</b> appear on top of the pile, the <b>first player to shout "Snap!"</b> wins the pile. Keep playing until <b>one player has all the cards</b> or until you want to stop.		<b>PSHE - Dreams and Goals</b> Draw a picture of something you want to achieve (e.g. cursive handwriting). <b>Write 1–2 sentences</b> about how you will reach your goal.
