


Literacy

Little Red

In Literacy we will be building, revisiting our phonics sounds and focusing on blending and reading simple sentences. We will be focusing on our new text 'Little Red'. We will be learning how to storytell, predict what happens, simple sentence writing, imaginative writing and creating story maps of favourite stories. We will be celebrating World Book Day too and enjoy different stories!



Understanding the World

Spring Festivals / Houses

In Understanding the World, we will learn about History and Cultural understanding. The children will learn about many festivals this term such as Holi, St Patricks Day, Mothers Day, Eid and Easter. We will also be looking at old and new houses and link this to our topic of Fairytales.



Communication and Language

We will explore traditional stories, events, characters, and settings, beginning to understand ideas about the past, present, and future within stories. Through the use of story maps, sequencing activities, retelling stories, and role play, we will develop our vocabulary, learn how stories are structured and develop confidence in telling our stories.

Expressive Arts and Design

Spring Festivals

We will be learning to develop complex stories using small world equipment or props. We will learn how to act out scenes from traditional stories and enhance these by using props and music. We will create artwork inspired by Mothers Day, World Book Day, Holi, Easter and St Patricks Day.



Maths

Number / Time / Shape

In Maths, we will be going in depth of numbers 9-10. We will be learning how to subitise and the composition of 10, Number bonds to 10 and doubling up to 10. We will also be learning about time and 3D shapes.

Healthy Me


Support your child at home:
