Science

Plants

In Science, we will explore plants by observing what's growing in our garden. We will learn the names of plant parts and identify plants in our local area, including fruit and vegetables.



Music

Rhythm

We continue working on beat and rhythm and will accompany songs using untuned percussion instruments, following simple rhythmic notation.

History

Toys

In History, we will explore how toys have changed over time. We will compare toys from today with those from grandparents' childhoods and from 100 years ago.



Art and Design

Earth Art

In Art, we will explore Earth Art by using natural, physical resources from the environment to create our own pieces.



Religious Education

Christianity

In R.E. we shall be learning how Christians celebrate Easter. We shall explore the symbols of Easter and how they relate to Spring.

PSHE

Healthy Me

In PSHE, we will explore being healthy and happy. We will focus on making healthy choices about food, hygiene, and medicine.

Maths

Place Value / Measures

In Maths, we will learn about place value within 50 and practice measuring objects using standard units. This will include length and height, as well as mass and volume.

French

Body Parts / Instructions

We will revise and extend our understanding of classroom instructions. We will also learn and practise vocabulary for parts of the body and face.

Physical Education

Yoga / Invasion Games

In PE, our indoor lessons will focus on yoga poses and mindfulness. Outdoor lessons will develop skills in attacking, defending, and moving with the ball.
