


English

Rosie Revere, Engineer

We will be writing an invention narrative and an explanation text inspired by 'Rosie Revere, Engineer'. We will develop our use of expanded noun phrases, conjunctions, correct punctuation and past and present tense.



Science

Animals including Humans

In Science, we will learn about animals, including humans. We will explore how animals have offspring that grow into adults and investigate the basic needs for survival, including water, food, and air.

We will consolidate understanding of simple note values and we will accompany songs with repeated rhythmic patterns.

Florence Nightingale Museum

Art and Design

Sonia Delaunay

In Art, we will study the work of Sonia Delaunay, exploring colour and pattern. We will sketch geometric designs and experiment with contrasting colours to create bold effects.



Religious Education

Easter

We will learn about how Christians celebrate Easter and reflect on themes of spring and new beginnings. We will also learning take part in an Easter themed activity.

PSHE

Healthy Me

In PSHE, we will learn about ways to stay physically and mentally healthy, including healthy eating, exercise, and hygiene.

Maths

Fractions / Time

In Maths we will learn about fractions and time. We will find halves, quarters and non-unit fractions, and divide shapes and quantities into equal parts. We will also tell the time to o'clock, half past, and quarter past/to, while continuing multiplication and division learning.

We shall be using adjectives to describe body parts and facial features.
