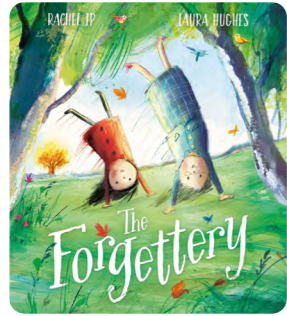


English

The Forgettery / It Fell from the Sky

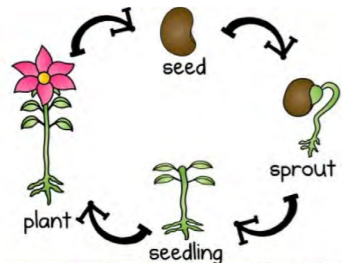
We will be reading 'The Forgettery' and using it to build on our language and grammar skills to write a finding memories narrative. We are also going to read 'It Fell from the Sky' to inspire complaint letter writing.



Science

Plants

We will be deepening our understanding of what plants need to grow and stay healthy, as well as investigating the key requirements for growth. We will also explore the different methods of seed dispersal and learn about the stages in the life cycle of a plant, from germination to reproduction.



Music

Recorders

We will learn the basics about recorders, including structure, sound and technique, and we will play pieces with B, A and G quaver notes.

Geography

Map Skills

We will be developing our map skills to help us locate the different countries of Europe and some of the physical features, including rivers and mountain ranges. We will also explore the different climates of the continent.



Design Technology

Structures

We will be exploring 3D structures inspired by famous landmarks. We will be drawing and labelling simple buildings, recognising 3D shapes in structures, and designing our own landmarks with a specific purpose.



Religious Education

Hinduism

We will be deepening our understanding of key beliefs and practices in Hinduism. We will explore a range of Hindu religious stories and reflect on the values they teach, learn about important Hindu festivals and the significance of prayer in daily life.

PSHE

Relationships

We will be exploring relationships and how to build trust with family and friends. We will be looking at when to keep information confidential, as well as exploring how to be responsible for our own safety.

Maths

Fractions / Money / Time

We will be building on our learning of fractions by learning to add and subtract fractions. We will also explore adding and subtracting money, and finding change. We will also be exploring telling the time to the nearest five minutes and exact minute.

French

Counting

We shall learn to count up to 12 in French and use numbers in context.

Physical Education

Handball / Athletics

We will be learning and developing skills and strategies for the game handball, including movement and quick decision making. We will also be developing our athletics skills including relay racing, jumping techniques and throwing accuracy.
