Geography

What is it like to live in Shanghai?

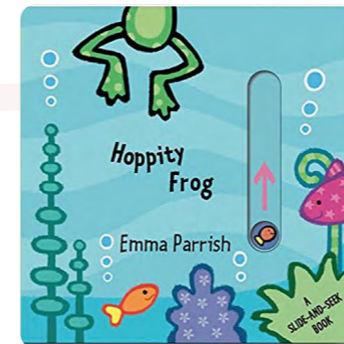
In Geography, we will explore the topic 'What is it like to live in Shanghai?', focusing on the human and physical features of the UK versus China. We will work towards comparing the two locations.



Design Technology

Mechanisms

In DT, we will explore our topic 'Mechanisms' by creating a moving storybook. We will design, make and evaluate our moving pictures.



Religious Education

Judaism

In RE, we will be learning about Judaism and comparing Jewish beliefs and traditions with our own beliefs and experiences, whether religious or non-religious.

PSHE

Changing Me

In PSHE, we will be exploring the topic 'Changing Me', learning about growth, change and how we can look after ourselves as we develop.

Science

Animals including Humans

In Science, we will be learning about animals including humans. We will identify and name common animals and explore different ways to sort and group them based on their features.

Pitch

In Music, we will continue working with tuned percussion instruments, with a focus on composition. We will listen to, sing and play simple tunes, and compose our own 8-beat melodies using minims and crotchets.
