

## English

### A River

In English, we will read 'A River' by Marc Martin and explore narrative and letter writing. We will focus on planning, editing and improving our writing while using descriptive language and conjunctions to extend sentences.



## History

### Schools

In History, we will explore how schools have changed over time. We will compare classrooms from the past and present and investigate what school life was like over 100 years ago.



## Art and Design

### London Landmarks

In Art, we will create clay sculptures inspired by famous London landmarks. We will explore clay modelling and joining techniques before designing and painting our own sculptures.



## Religious Education

### Judaism / Christianity / Islam

In R.E. we will compare prayer in Judaism, Christianity and Islam. We will learn about similarities and differences in how people pray across the three religions.

## PSHE

### Changing Me

In PSHE, we will focus on the topic 'Changing Me'. We will learn about life cycles, growing from young to old, body changes and looking ahead positively.

## Science

### Animals including Humans

In Science we will explore the importance of exercise, healthy eating and hygiene. We will also investigate the effects of sugary drinks on teeth.



## Music

### Pitch

In Music, we will develop our tuned percussion skills by playing simple melodies following music notation. We will also learn how to improvise melodies using given notes and they will prepare paired and whole-class performances.

### Thames River Cruise
