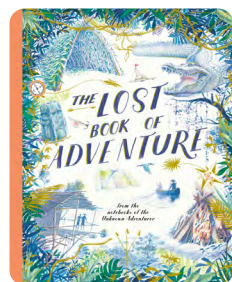


## English

### The Lost Book of Adventure

We will explore 'The Lost Book of Adventure' and learn to write an exciting survival narrative, developing ideas through prediction, poetry, character work and vocabulary. We will also learn to write a survival guide using clear instructions and formal language.



## Science

### Earth and Space

We will be exploring Earth and Space, with a particular focus on the lunar cycle and how day and night occur. We will learn about the movement of the Earth and Moon, how the Moon's phases change over time, and why shadows and daylight vary throughout the day.



## Music

### Rounds and Singing

In Music, we will sing and play three-part rounds enhancing listening and ensemble playing skills. We will also accompany songs on classroom instruments playing chords and rhythmic and melodic ostinati.

## Geography

### What is life like in the Alps?

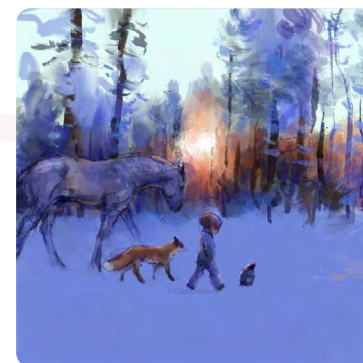
We will investigate the question 'What is life like in the Alps?' through looking at the human and physical features of the area and comparing it to our local area.



## Art and Design

### Drawing

We will be investigating how drawing can express emotion, movement and depth, inspired by the work of Charlie Mackesy and Elizabeth Catlett.



## Religious Education

### Sikhism

We will learn about key Sikh beliefs, explore traditions such as weddings and pilgrimages to the Golden Temple, and deepen our understanding of why Sikhs are so devoted to their faith.

## PSHE

### Being Me in My World

We will explore new challenges, set personal goals, and reflect on our rights and responsibilities both in school and as citizens of our country. We will also learn how our behaviour affects others and discover how democracy and having a voice help shape our school community.

## Maths

### Place Value

We will build on our knowledge of place value by working with numbers up to 1,000,000, including reading, writing, ordering, and rounding. We will also explore Roman numerals, powers of 10, and use number lines and partitioning to build confidence.

## Physical Education

### Outdoor Activities / Tag Rugby

We will develop our communication, teamwork, and problem-solving skills through Outdoor Adventurous Activities (OAA), including navigation and map reading tasks. We will also build our understanding of tag rugby by practising throwing, catching, dodging, and applying a variety of tactics.
