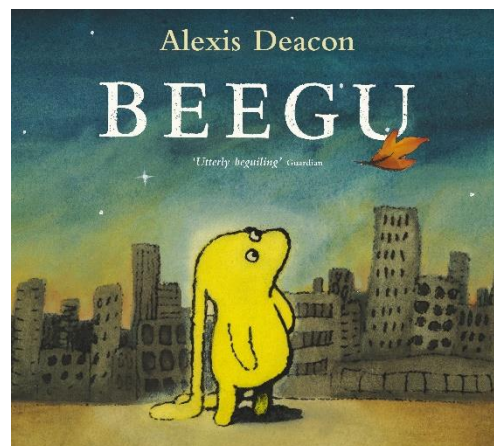


Key information for Year 1.

Name:							
Combine words to make sentences orally and in writing.							
Join words and clauses using 'and'.							
Separate words with spaces.							
Demarcate some sentences with capital letters and end with punctuation - full stop, exclamation, question mark							
Use capital letters for names, places, days of the week and the personal pronoun 'I'.							
Use basic descriptive language.							
Sequence sentences to form a short narrative or piece of information writing.							
Orally rehearse sentences before writing.							
Re-read and check writing makes sense.							
Use phonic knowledge and skills from FS and Y1 to spell some phonemically regular words correctly and make phonically-plausible attempts at others.							
Spell Y1 common exception words (many).							
Spell words with simple suffixes and prefixes correctly. e.g. singular and plural 's' and 'es', verb endings 'ed', 'ing' and 'er', 'est' (many) and the prefix 'un'.							
Form lower-case letters in the correct direction, starting and finishing in the right place.							
Form capital letters and digits 0-9.
